Harness Inspections

Prior to using a harness or fall protection equipment, the equipment should be inspected.

What to look for when inspecting a Harness:

- Harness should be free of the following:
 - Burns, holes, &cuts in the webbing.
 - Fraying around the grommets & webbing
 - Mold or discoloration
 - Rust & cracks on hardware.
- The harness must have a legible label that is intact.
- The harness must be inspected & tagged annually by A fall protection competent person.
- The Harness should be hung by back D ring when not In use.







If defects are found the harness should be destroyed and disposed of to prevent use.
